- 4. **Read John 10:4.** What are some other "voices" in culture that compete with the voice of Jesus? Which do you find the most distracting?
- 5. Jesus says that his sheep "know his voice." How can we get better at recognizing his voice and knowing his will in our daily lives?
- 6. **Read John 10:11-13**. When you picture Jesus laying down his life for you, how does that shape your understanding of God's love? How might it affect the way you face challenges this week?
- 7. How does the Good Shepherd's sacrifice reshape the way you think about real freedom and security?
- 8. The best place to be is in the flock of the Good Shepherd. What is one step you can take this week to stay closer to Jesus?

John 10:11-15

¹¹ "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. ¹² The hired hand is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. ¹³ The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.

¹⁵ just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and I lay down my life for the sheep.
