

# **Palm Sunday**

On Palm Sunday, the crowds welcomed Jesus with "Hosanna to the Son of David."

On Good Friday, the same crowd rejected Jesus with the cry, "Crucify him," illustrating the fickleness of the human heart.

Join in the services of Holy week: relive the Central Mysteries of our Faith, the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus and, put all distractions aside.

# **Holy Week Schedule of Services**

"Jesus Christ Superstar" is a very popular rock opera. The music was composed by Andrew Lloyd Webber. The overture to the opera follows the Four Gospels. It begins with the triumphant arrival of Jesus into Jerusalem to a tumultuous ticker-tape-like palm-waiving welcome by his followers and onlookers. They want to make him king and hail him: "Hosanna to the Son of David." It is a 3 Act Drama, which chronicles the Passion and Death of Jesus. The exuberant joyful greeting of Palm Sunday – 'Hosanna to the Son of David' - gives way to the angry 'lynch-mob' cries of Good Friday, "Crucify him", illustrating the fickleness of the human heart.

For us too, Holy Week is High Drama. It begins with Palm Sunday. The script was written by the Four Evangelists – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The overture to the drama is Palm Sunday, with the reading of the Passion – Matthew 26: 14-27: 66. It is the overture to a 3-act-drama: the betrayal and Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper on Holy Thursday; the Passion and death on Good Friday; the Easter Resurrection.

### We are invited to be 'actors,' not 'spectators,' in the Drama of Holy Week.

As Christians, we are not merely invited to read the script — Mark's account of the Passion. Jesus invites us to participate in the 3-act- drama of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday in his mandate, "Do this in remembrance of me." We are invited to not only Re-call but to Re-Live and to Re-enact the Central Mystery of our Faith. During his Passion, Jesus was abandoned by his followers who fell asleep, ran away, denied or betrayed him. He invites us not to abandon him as we prepare to celebrate this central mystery of our faith — the Passion, death and Resurrection of Jesus. Come to all the services this Holiest Week of the Church's year.

Easter Sunday, March 31st: 8:00, 10:30 a.m., 12 noon (Spanish Mass), Renewal of Baptismal Promises.






