Lenten Regulations on Fasting and Abstinence

Days of Fast & Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting is to be observed by those, **ages 18 to 59 (inclusive)**.
On Fast days one full meal is allowed and two smaller meals.
Eating between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence: All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Abstinence is observed by those who are **14 years of age and older**.

On days of abstinence no meat is allowed.

Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday, are days of abstinence.

- **Note:** If a parishioner is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are encouraged to practice some form of self-denial suitable to their condition.

CRS Lenten Practice – Operation Rice Bowl

In the Gospel of Ash Wednesday (**Mt 6: 1-6; 12-18**) Jesus outlines **three practices** for the Lenten season: **fasting, Almsgiving and Prayer**.

- **Operation Rice Bowl:** You will receive Catholic Relief Services (CRS) Operation Rice Bowl; parishioners are encouraged to participate in **ORB**.
- Place the **Rice Bowl** in the middle of the family dining room table during the season of Lent. Each family is encouraged to eat one frugal meal on a designated day – preferably Friday - each week during Lent.
- Suggestions for the frugal meal menu can be gleaned from the **CRS booklet**, or, can be agreed to by each family. We will collect the proceeds from the Rice Bowls on the last Sunday of Lent. **Pick up Rice Bowls on tables at Church exits.**

Why Ashes?

For centuries, Catholic Christians have marked the beginning of the season of Lent by receiving ash on their foreheads on Ash Wednesday. This tradition

has its roots in the **Old Testament**, where wearing ashes was a **common sign of repentance** for sins, and a sign of one's humility before God. Since **Lent** is a season of **penitential renewal** through prayer, fasting, **almsgiving** (Mt 6: 1 – 18) it's appropriate that this ancient sign marks the beginning of the season.
