

Salvation

Personal Study Guide - Week of 2/8/26

Overview

Salvation is God's loving rescue plan through Jesus. Scripture teaches that sin separates humanity from God, but through repentance and faith in Christ, we are forgiven, restored, and given eternal life. This truth reminds us that our hope rests in what Jesus has done... not in what we can accomplish.

Take a few minutes each day to read, reflect, and respond.

A Quick Encouragement

Move slowly through these passages. Ask God to help you understand His truth personally, not just intellectually. Let Scripture shape your heart, your perspective, and your daily decisions.

Day 1 – Recognizing Our Need

Read: Romans 3:23; Romans 6:23

Reflection

Sin affects every person and creates separation from God. Recognizing our need for salvation is the first step toward restoration.

Questions

- How do these verses describe humanity's spiritual condition?
- Why is it important to honestly acknowledge our need for saving?
- How does understanding sin shape your appreciation for God's grace?

Day 2 – God’s Gift of Grace

Read: Ephesians 2:8–9

Reflection: Salvation is not something we earn. It is a gift given through faith in Jesus.

Questions

- What does this passage teach about grace and faith?
- Why do people sometimes struggle to accept free grace?
- How can you remind yourself daily that salvation is a gift?

Day 3 – Jesus Is the Only Way

Read: John 14:6; Acts 4:11–12

Reflection: Jesus is not one option among many... He is the only source of salvation and a restored relationship with God.

Questions

- What do these verses reveal about who Jesus is?
- Why can believing this feel challenging in today’s culture?
- How does trusting Jesus bring confidence and hope?

Day 4 – New Life in Christ

Read: John 3:3; 2 Corinthians 5:17

Reflection: Salvation brings transformation. Faith in Jesus leads to new spiritual life and identity.

Questions

- What does it mean to be born again or made new in Christ?
 - Where have you seen evidence of spiritual growth in your life?
 - What areas of your life still need surrender to Jesus?

Day 5 – Assurance and Security

Read: 1 John 5:13; John 10:27–30

Reflection: God wants believers to live with confidence in their salvation and security in His care.

Questions

- What do these passages teach about assurance?
- How does security in salvation impact fear, doubt, or anxiety?
- How can you live differently knowing you belong to God?
