An excerpt from Pastor Elisabeth's sermon this past weekend on the Gospel of [John 1:29-42](#).

*"Jesus says, come and see. And seeing is never the end of the story. Everyone who truly sees Jesus begins to move: toward hope, toward change, toward action. Seeing turns into relationship, and relationship turns into responsibility for self and for others, and is lived out by loving and serving our neighbors."*



She later went on to say, "Come and see' becomes: Come and listen to a story that challenges your own. Come and notice where suffering is being normalized. Come and stay when it would be easier to leave. And because Jesus does not invite us to do this alone, discipleship spreads through relationship, not pressure. Which means our practices of justice look less like heroic acts and more like shared ones: showing up together, learning together, telling the truth together, refusing to let one another grow numb. Some of these practices are quiet. Some are public. Some are as simple—and as hard—as asking, who is my neighbor?"

but to pause, pray, and recommit ourselves to listening deeply, returning to the table, and doing the ongoing work of becoming a church shaped more fully by Christ's love, justice, and truth.
