




documentary "Speaking Grief" and a conversation with Pastor Elisabeth and Sue Harvey, MSW, about finding space for grief and hope during the holidays.

Endowment Fund 2025 update

An endowment fund is a lasting source of support for our ministry. Gifts to the fund are invested, and the earnings help sustain our programs and mission for generations to come. The endowment fund is currently at \$300,000. Distributions from the endowment fund totaled \$11,200 in 2025 and were disbursed as follows:

- \$5,600 to support the congregations missions
- \$2,800 to support seminary students
- \$1,450 to support the refresh capital project
- \$1,350 to support stewardship training
