C. S. Lewis' famous Christian fantasy classic will be used to prompt student writing. Each day we will watch a short segment of the DVD and then practice a variety of fundamental writing formats:

- * Construct a **dialogue** between Aslan and the children (great lesson about Jesus!)
- * Prepare a **characterization** of Lucy? Susan? Edmund? Peter? Aslan? Mr. Tumnus?
- * Practice **descriptive writing** of minotaurs and monsters!
- * Organize a **How-To essay** on building a Narnia theme park? Making Turkish Delight?
- * Write a **precis** (that's a fancy word for "summary") of the story.
- * Learn how to **apply scripture** to a plot/character - using quotations

This week is designed to help students improve their organizational skills, sentence structure, and confidence in (and love of) writing. Students will use the classroom chrome books (good keyboarding practice!). Each student will bring whatever writing skills he/she has to this class and have a fun week improving on them!
