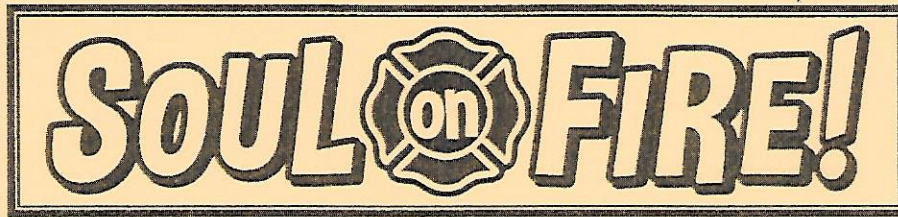


SPRING CONCERT 2019

To fit the theme, we will wear the fire colors of yellow and orange. All brigadiers (**vocal music students**) will need to get a specific brand, style and color of short-sleeved tee-shirt as explained below. The shirts can be acquired very inexpensively--between \$2.00 & \$5.00. Several sources are listed, but I would recommend that you purchase sooner rather than later since you may prefer or need to order your child's size online. Here is what to get and where to get it.

Brand: Gildan  
Style: G200B (youth sizes), G200 (adult sizes)  
Colors: Safety Orange OR Daisy Yellow

Available in-store sources: *Hobby Lobby* (Daisy Yellow available in all youth & adult sizes; please note, *Hobby Lobby's* Orange is **NOT** the Safety Orange)

*Michael's* (Daisy Yellow available at both store locations in all youth & adult sizes; Safety Orange available only at Rosedale store in all adult sizes and youth medium)

In order to accommodate song movements, the shirt should be long enough so that no skin is showing when arms are fully extended above the head. The children are to also wear **long navy blue school uniform pants**. **Dark shoes** are preferable, as well, if your child has them. Thank you for your willingness to provide what your child needs to help us achieve a uniform look on stage.

In accordance with school policy, **all vocal music students** are required to be present for the concert. An absence will result in a lowered vocal music grade for the fourth quarter. However, if your child absolutely has to miss for some reason, a written excuse **must** be submitted to me **before** the night of the program. The excuse **must state the reason for the absence** in order for it to be considered in the grading process.

Sound the alarm! Jesus has ignited the fire of God's love in our hearts! The Holy Spirit fans that flame to keep it burning brightly in our souls. *May 14* will entertain you, but will also inspire and challenge you to share the light of His good news with the world. Don't miss it!
