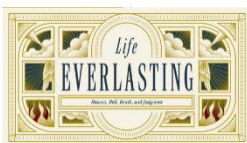

Can I skip purchasing a Study Guide and sign up for Digital Access only?

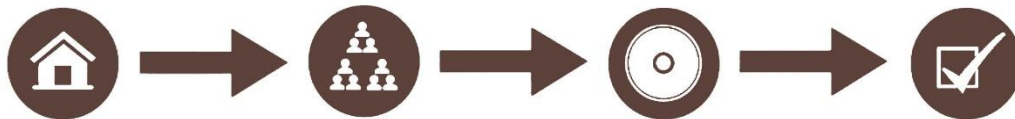
