- 11:00am - bilingual Mass (English & Spanish)
- 12:00 noon - official activities conclude



Information for Drivers:

Gathering is on foot at the O'Dea High School Parking Lot, behind 802 E. Terry Ave.

Passengers with mobility concerns should be dropped off at the northeast (Marion Street) entrance to St. James Cathedral.

Free Parking is available in the Cabrini Center garage. Our busses have filled.

Directions

To reach the Cathedral take the James Street Exit from I-5 and head East (up the hill) on James Street and then take a left on 9th Avenue. The Cathedral is located two blocks north on the right hand side.

How to Obtain the Jubilee Indulgence

The faithful can obtain the Jubilee indulgence if, having celebrated the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, they devoutly visit any Jubilee site and there, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God.
