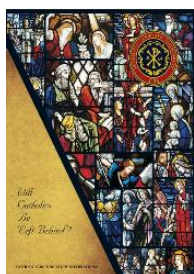

Will Catholics Be “Left Behind”? Perhaps no other book of the Bible fascinates us more than *The Book of Revelation*.
