REGISTRATION STEPS TO FOLLOW

- Fill out registration and health form completely.
 - Fill in circle above for the camp that you are attending.
 - Parent or Guardian signature is required.
- Send in your form (and min. \$100 deposit) to your church's camp coordinator or to VCBC. Your \$100 deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. Please notify VCBC if your camper can't attend so others might attend. In the event of an illness or other emergency please call the office to discuss a refund less a \$35 handling fee.

REFUNDS

No refunds will be made for campers who withdraw before the end of the camping session, except in the case of doctor's orders or family emergency. VCBC reserves the right to dismiss any camper—without refund— whose conduct is not in the best interest of others.
