Why Plant?

Church planting follows the New Testament pattern of making disciples.

The missionary strategy of Paul to fulfill the great commission was to plant churches in areas of influence to reach as many people groups as possible (Acts 14:21-23, 16:9-15, 12; Titus 1:5; Romans 15:19-21). In this pattern the Gospel is brought to an unreached area and new believers are equipped and encouraged to make disciples themselves as the church community grows. Afterwards, the process of planting a new church begins again; this pattern best aligns with the New Testament example of making disciples.

A new church provides unique discipleship opportunities among the unchurched.

Studies confirm that the average new church gains 1/3 to 2/3 of its members from those not attending any worshipping body whereas churches over ten to fifteen years of age gain 80 to 90 percent of new members by transfer from other congregations¹. While many established churches do effectively reach the lost there are simply not enough of these ministries making an overall impact in evangelism. The average new church will bring lost people into God's Kingdom at six to eight times the rate of an established church of the same size².

A new church can reach diverse populations.

In general, new churches are nimble enough to identify and reach the emerging populations and new people groups in a changing cultural landscape. Younger adults are typically found in higher percentages in newer congregations.

A new church releases new, creative disciples and leaders to impact the city for Christ.

Because of growth factors and a missional focus new churches are positioned to engage higher percentages of their members' spiritual gifts and natural abilities. As a result they can develop and release innovative, kingdom-focused disciples who convey the Gospel through their personal relationships and in their vocations.

About Brunswick

Brunswick MD is in Southern Frederick County Maryland, which is a part of the greater Washington DC metroplex. There are about 20,000 people living in the target area for the church plant.

Brunswick has grown by over 25% in the last 10 years in population. Over 1500 homes being built in Brunswick Crossing- catering to commuters who travel to Washington DC to work. This emerging community has a great need for churches.

Brunswick is nestled along the Potomac river, has a historic

Strategy

Simple Church Model

Everything we do needs to move the people of Grace Fellowship to **know** the gospel, **live** the gospel and **give** the gospel away. We will therefore focus on the following ministry opportunities:

Worship Gathering

Corporately, we will spend time in learning the gospel and it's radical power in our lives. Our worship services will be unapologetically contemporary, informal and will focus on creating environments that unchurched people will love to attend. The teaching will be solidly founded on the bible, saturated in the gospel, and high in application. No topic is off-limits from the bank account to the bedroom- the gospel affects it all.

Groups

Groups (otherwise known as small groups) are where we will learn to live out the gospel. All groups must have an intentional leader, a relational environment and reproducible processes to multiply their groups. We will work hard to encourage all who attend Grace Fellowship to be a part of this primary avenue of spiritual formation.

Student/Children's Ministries

We will devote resources and energy towards shaping a God-centered worldview in the lives of our children and students.

Our first efforts will be in establishing a strong children's ministry. Our goal is a 50/50 blend of a children's worship gathering and smaller children's groups. At first, our youth ministries will be in cooperation with Grace Community Church, (their Youth ministries meet on Wednesday nights). When it becomes prudent, we will pursue beginning our own youth ministry.

Community Outreach

We want the people of Grace Fellowship to be our walking billboards and how we give the gospel away. We will spend our outreach dollars in outrageous acts of generosity and community "blitz" events. We will leverage the people of Grace Fellowship to demonstrate to the community know that we are here and we care through service projects, school partnerships, and connecting with other partners that serve the needs of the community.

Strategy continued

We have a 4-year strategic plan consisting of:

Preparation Sept 2016- Sept 2017.

Our focus during this time is to recruit workers and prepare the soil for the harvest. We are working on creating the foundation for the church.

Recruit prayer partners and cultivate a culture of prayer among the families of Grace Fellowship
Recruit a launch team of committed families and individuals to both evangelize and help lead the church ministries

•Begin meeting for a weekly bible study with these families

•Establish strategic partnerships to raise funds

- •Building strategic relationships with community leaders in Brunswick
- •Find adequate space for launch a public worship service
- •Establish founding documents
- •Establish website and social media presence

•Have at least 10 families/40 people committed to launching the church

the community with a weekly worship gathering and community outreach and also develop small groups.

- •Have several momentum-building outreach events in the community
- •Develop small group leader training and begin launching groups
- •Develop formal children's ministry
- •Continue fund raising
- •Develop a story-telling video team
