Laura will offer quadrivalent flu shots and high dose (recommended flu shots for those 65 and older) vaccines. Without insurance, the standard shot is \$30, while others may be higher. Blue Cross Blue Shield and Medicare are accepted. Please bring your card with you. Shots will be available on Sunday, October 21, 9:15—9:45, and after worship until 12:30 in Room 201 (the Fisher-Tarlton Classroom). 2019 CHURCH DIRECTORY

For a very small fee each month our church directory will be continually updated on a password protected site on our church website and also on your own smart phone app. They will also provide a format in which we can print out a color directory for those who would like to have a hard copy. A fee of \$2.00 will be needed to help offset the cost for us to print it at the church.
