On Communion Sundays, we give you an opportunity to contribute to our "local missions"

fund. This fund is used to provide bags of food and hygiene items for our neighbors, as well as help with immediate needs of those in our community. Thanks to your continued generosity, our fund is in a good place.

This Sunday, instead of collecting contributions to our fund, we want to extend the scope of our impact by giving the local missions offering directly to one of our local mission partners. This month, our partner is **Blue Ridge Hope**. Blue Ridge Hope is a local non-profit that provides mental health services to those in our area on a sliding scale. Over the last year, the need for affordable counseling has increased dramatically and they work to secure grants and private donations to offset the cost for those without the ability to pay. Along with mental health services, Blue Ridge Hope also provides an after school program for middle school and high school students in our community. In addition to being one of our neighbors and mission partners, a couple of our church members work for Blue Ridge Hope!


