

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON RULES 2020

Due to the United States 2020 Pandemic, the New York State Attorney General Charities Bureau, issued guidance for conducting virtual meetings for Not-for-Profit corporations.

On April 17, 2020, Executive Order 202.18 was issued by Governor Cuomo of the State of New York, to modify Section 603(b) of the Not-for-Profit Corporations Law to the extent necessary to permit annual meetings of members to be held remotely or by electronic means.

Beginning in September 2020 the Northeastern District Office began working toward changing our in-person Conference, in such a way that the Laws of the Land would be adhered to, and that the Requirements of the Christian and Missionary Alliance would be fulfilled.

In light of the extraordinary events of the 2020 Pandemic, the Rules Committee has examined both the committee reports, as well as the proceedings of the 89th Annual Northeastern District and Prayer Conference 2020 which have been held virtually; and recognizing none of us hold a Jurisprudence degree, nevertheless, to the best of our knowledge, we find everything to be correct according to both the modification of the Corporations Law of NY, as well as in agreement with all the governing documents of the Christian and Missionary Alliance.
