#### Today's Message:

"And he went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction among the people." Matthew 4:23

We begin our study of the Book of Romans and in doing this we will hopefully discover truths that will help transform our lives and that we will be ever more grateful for the Gospel of Christ and for the apostle Paul. In doing this study, we must come to terms with some of the assumptions we may have that have made us complacent about our faith. Hopefully, it will also be evident that we are in some ways similar to the audience in Rome to whom Paul is addressing this letter. The very first topic we will encounter is the Gospel – what it is and why it is so much a focal point of Paul's letter to the Romans. We will also see that the theme of the Gospel starts back in the Garden at the time of the fall. So, we hope you enjoy this study and that you are challenged and encouraged in your faith journey as we grow in Christ together.
