**Today's Message:**

“For if I preach the gospel, that gives me no ground for boasting. For necessity is laid upon me. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel!”  
1 Corinthians 9:16

The core of the Gospel is faith. Faith in Christ Jesus as the Son of God and Son of Man, who made full intercession for us before His Father. As Isaiah saw the glory of the Lord of hosts, he was instantly convicted of his sinful state. We, too, must realize that we are woeful sinners in need of a Savior. Jesus is just that Savior, sinless and full of righteousness. He is able to save all who trust wholly in Him and call upon His name for forgiveness and mercy. We therefore, like Paul, will come to realize that it is the good news of the resurrection of Jesus and His victory over sin and the grave, that we, too, can be like those in Rome – with a faith anchored in Christ and demonstrated by our witness to the world. Let us encourage one another to tell the story of redemption through the blood of Christ.
