### Today's Message:

"To the Lord our God belongs mercy and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against him and have not obeyed the voice of the Lord our God by walking in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets." Daniel 9:9-10

Paul shifts his attention from the lost who say there is no God to the Jews who live as if there is no God. He expands his demonstration of the sinfulness of man and our need for the faithful righteous movement of God. He explains how the Jews have been entrusted with the very words of God and how they have been chosen to bring God's Word to the world. Even though they have been unfaithful, it doesn't nullify the faithfulness of God. The total depravity of all mankind is demonstrated by the lack of fear of His judgment. However, he continues by showing that it wasn't the law that could save, but rather it is the law that condemns. Thus, it is only by faith in Jesus Christ that we have righteousness, and both the Jew and the Gentile are in need of the atoning work of Jesus Christ through the shedding of His blood. May we be given the faith we need to trust in Jesus only.
