The Gospel To Rome - "Gentile Hope"

Today's Message:

"Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed." John 3:18-20

Paul's desire for the church to live in harmony is evident as he continues to cover the topic of the strong and the weak and also applies it to the harmony that needs to exist between Jewish believers and Gentile believers. He wants the weak to not think of themselves as victims and act in resentment with a critical spirit. He also doesn't want the strong to act with contempt for the weak and be overbearing. Rather, as he considers himself of the strong, he wants the strong to reach out and lift up, or bear the weak; not with superiority, but in love. He then uses Christ as the example; the One upon whom all our reproaches fell. May we see that God wants us to all be strong, so that we can be filled with joy and peace serving one another in love. This is the fulfillment of the Jews and the hope of the Gentiles. It is the grace of the strong and the path for the weak.
