Today’s Message:

“He delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will deliver us again. You also must help us by prayer, so that many will give thanks on our behalf for the blessing granted us through the prayers of many.” 2 Corinthians 1:10-11

We often think that we have no part in the spread of the Gospel. We may think that we are beneath those with most Bible knowledge or wisdom. Satan will use such thoughts to cause us to cease to tell our story of how we have come to know Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, and how our lives today are different from how we lived before we came to trust and believe in Jesus.
