WELCOME TO THE ST. MATTHEW'S SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM!

St. Matthew's Summer Camp offers a faith-based, theme-driven program for rising 5K, 1st, and 2nd graders. Our camp provides a safe, engaging environment where children learn, create, and grow through a blend of academics, STEM, the arts, and play, aligned with South Carolina standards.

Your camper will have fun in focused and small-group activities to allow for individualized attention and support in areas parents feel would benefit their child most. Campers will enjoy in-house field trips, end-of-week showcases, and hands-on experiences that make each week special.

The summer concludes with a keepsake camp book celebrating friendships, learning, and memories made along the way.

HOURS

The Preschool opens at 7:30am and the Summer Camp Program starts at 8:30am. We will end the camp day at 4:30pm where the Preschool day ends at 5:30pm.

DAILY CAMPER NEEDS

Campers will need to bring a water bottle with their name on it and a towel (this will be used if we decide to do outside activities that require them to sit). Kindergarten Campers will need to bring an extra change of clothes.

HOW THE THEMES AND END OF WEEK SHOWCASING WORK:

During the week of Jesus, the Carpenter/Woodworking, we will do many activities building with wood in our centers. A center example would be if your camper chooses the science area, they will have different types of wood to transform an idea into a creation, like a bird house, special keepsakes box, etc. We will have an in-house field trip where a builder will come in to teach us how to construct a bench for the playground. Campers will be journaling in their keepsakes book through pictures and words about their weekly experiences. Then on Friday, they will get an opportunity to showcase their project to the other campers.

We are a faith-based Program. As part of our Summer Camp Program, we will help out in the church's food pantry garden by weeding and picking vegetables. This gives campers the experience of nurturing their community, teaching kindness, compassion, and community service.

Also, this program will give campers support to boost areas of academics that you feel they need strengthening.
