# Beauty, Wonder and Mystery (Worship Service)

#### Ministry Head: Mary Paul

Acolyte: Assist the clergy with worship services, such as carry the processional cross, light and carry worship service candles, distribute offering plates to ushers, etc.

Altar Guild: Care for and prepare the church altar, vestments, vessels and linens.

Choir: Lead congregational singing or perform musical offerings to enhance worship.

Eucharistic ministers: Use the chalice to share wine during Holy Communion.

Flower Guild: Arrange and care for flowers to enhance the worship space; create seasonal floral and plant decorations.

Lector: Read scripture and prayers to the congregation.

Usher: Distribute bulletins, assist with seating, collect offerings and help the communion service to flow.

Cursillo: Attend a 3-day weekend course to deepen one's faith, then participate in activities with other Cursillistas during the year.

Education for Ministry (EfM): Attend a lay theological education program that combines worship, group/individual study, and spiritual reflection in a small group.

Episcopal Youth Community (EYC): Help middle and high school youth to grow in their faith, build community, and participate in various activities and events.

Preschool/Children's Christian Formation: Have fun teaching children about Bible stories, do arts & crafts and build their faith

Vacation Bible School (VBS): Help children enjoy a week of fun Christian activities, such as arts & crafts, learning songs, praying and hearing Bible stories.

Graphics: Design posters and signage for events and member nametags.

## Fostering Fellowship (Evangelism and Hospitality)

Greeter: Welcome people to worship services and assist newcomers.

Sit 'n Stitch: Join other needlework artists to stitch creations for yourself or to donate for healing purposes (prayer shawls, blankets, etc.)

Network of Care: Help those in need connect with social services and other support for housing, healthcare and more.

Visitations: Visit the homebound to show how they are loved and cared for.

Asylum Seekers/Refugees: Provide information and support about housing, food, education and legal counsel to those seeking asylum or refugees.

Free Medical Clinic: Provide health care to those in need.
