CONFESSION OF SINS AND ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

C: But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

(We pause to remember our sin, but more importantly to remember God's great love and forgiveness)

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

KYRIE PRAYER (Spoken)

P: In peace let us pray to the Lord.

C: Lord, have mercy.

P: For the peace from above and for our salvation let us pray to the Lord.

C: Lord, have mercy.

P: For the peace of the whole world, for the well-being of the Church of God, and for the unity of all let us pray to the Lord.

C: Lord, have mercy.

P: For this holy house and for all who offer here their worship and praise let us pray to the Lord.

C: Lord, have mercy.

P: Help, save, comfort, and defend us, gracious Lord.

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE READINGS

Our Old Testament reading is **Deuteronomy 31.15-20**. As Israel stands ready to enter the land, the Lord appears to Moses and Joshua to warn that the people will chase other gods and to give a song that will witness against their drift and call them back.

The Psalm is **Psalms 1**. This psalm contrasts the rooted, blessed life of those who delight in God's instruction with the empty, unstable way of the wicked. ***We will speak the Psalm together.***

Today's Gospel is **Luke 14.25-35**. Jesus tells the crowds to count the cost of discipleship—placing Him above every allegiance, bearing the cross, and staying "salty" in steadfast devotion.
