A note From the pastor

The Gospel of Matthew concludes with Jesus teaching the disciples the concept of multiplication. Matthew 28:18-20 reads: And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been

given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." This passage is referred to as "The Great Commission." The word commission literally means "an instruction, command, or duty given to a person or group of people." Jesus instructs his disciples to continue the process of making other disciples. As we read the Gospels and Acts, we see this ragtag group of 12, soon grow to 500, then explode to thousands, and grow the global Church that exists today. As followers of Jesus, we are to help others learn about Jesus and begin following him too. We're called to do this wherever we go! And some of us go to a lot of places (work, school, family events, stores, restaurants, and all the other places our cars and feet take us). Everywhere we go, we need to seek opportunities to share how Jesus has impacted our lives and invite others to follow Jesus too. As others come to know Jesus, we celebrate their decisions through baptism, the public display of believing in Jesus as our Lord and Savior and confessing his death for our sins, and the new life that we have because of our resurrected Savior.

As a response to this passage, we recently launched the Great Commission Initiative! This concept is being rolled out through our Sunday School classes and will continue to be shared with the congregation. We're asking the church to be intentional in praying for and reaching the lost...those who need Jesus. Church, we're challenging ourselves to pray for people by name. Also, pray that God will use us to reach them.

Here are some practical steps you can take to start praying for and reaching the lost: (1) simply ask someone how you can pray for them; (2) when someone shares a challenge or difficulty, ask to pray for them at that time; (3) tell others about your faith (be vulnerable and share the ups and downs)...people desire genuine and authentic relationships; (4) help meet a physical need and point to how Jesus met people's needs; (5) invite someone to Sunday School and Church. I'll conclude with this encouragement. As we approach the Thanksgiving and Christmas season, this is the easiest time to ask someone to come with you to church. Many of our family and friends will accept the invitation, if we just ask. Over 20 years ago, I was one of those. Let's commit to praying for and reaching those that need Jesus!
