Q: When do you leave for Liberia?

A: It has been difficult to come up with a date for departure due to the delay in shipping our container. Finally, after all the difficulties we encountered (it's a long story), our shipping container has left the port of Houston, Texas and is in transit to Monrovia, Liberia; due to arrive on August 9th. Thank you for helping us with supplies and money to purchase most of the items on our list! Our tickets have been purchased and our final date of departure is Wednesday, August 8th!!!!

Q: Have you finished building your house?

A: The house is 95% completed. All the tile has been laid and we just had a water tower installed at the back of the house. Apparently, it takes a village to raise a water tower, too. The finishing touches on the house will be completed when the container arrives.

Q: What do the kids think about all this?

A: Fortunately, our kids are excited and cannot wait to be in Liberia. They are tired of the delays and just want to get there already. They will continue to be home schooled and will be learning a lot about life on the other side of the planet. We're expecting the move to impact our 15 year old daughter the most, but she has been amazingly positive and open to the experience.

Q: What will you be doing over there?

A: We have a lot of ideas and dreams but we have to be in Liberia to begin forming relationships and discerning needs before we can really determine the steps God wants us to follow. We know that it will take all of us some time to adjust to a whole new way of life and a different culture. We have a huge advantage because of Thomas' experience in both cultures; however, we realize that we need to take things slowly. Our passions include youth empowerment through sports and education, health, and agriculture. We have detailed plans to impact each area.

Q: How are you going to do all these things and what can we do to help?

A: We are trusting in God for His provision to accomplish through us what He wants. Right now, we are seeking \$2,500 in monthly support for the needs of our family for the next two years while we get established. We are also exploring the possibility of an impact investment fund for our larger projects (i.e. school, health care facility, etc). Hopefully, we will have the opportunity to be mission trip facilitators through Merge Ministries for those wanting to participate on short term mission trips in Africa (including Liberia). We will be looking for healthy ministries to partner with, as well. We are still selling coffee through Top of the Lake Coffee (Jaime's uncle's ministry) to raise funds for our soccer ministry.
