Chaos 10 will begin November 10th at 7:00 p.m.

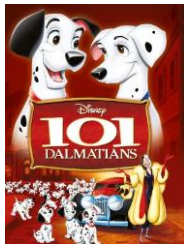
WELCA Coordinating Committee
