In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

If we're honest, we prefer our lives to be more like a motorboat rather than a sailboat. We can control a motorboat, unlike a sailboat that is propelled by wind. But the truth is, because of sin, we often propel ourselves off course. Instead of using a motor boat with mechanical propellers, God calls us to get into a sailboat, and to trust the Holy Spirit as the wind that guides our lives. It's scary to give up control, and yet, when we do so, God moves us to new horizons that are far greater than anything we can imagine.

Together, let us confess our sin, our desire for control, trusting that God will forgive us and propel us to where we need to go:

Holy God, we are sorry for taking control rather than trusting you. We are sorry for the ways we have hurt others, and help us to forgive those who have hurt us. Holy Spirit, give us the courage to trust in you as the wind-powered propeller of our sailboat, rather than get into a motor boat that we can control. Forgive us, renew us, and remind us you will always get us back on course because you love us so much.

Dear beloved children of God, receive this Good News, God forgives you of your sin. You are loved and claimed by God! God will always give you another chance to be propelled by the Spirit in ways that share God's goodness and love in the world. Amen.
