

## Kindermusik at Resurrection Program Guidelines

**MAKE-UP CLASSES** – If you miss a class due to illness or otherwise, you are welcome to do a make-up class within the same semester. Once classes begin, there will be a registration for make-up classes on our website [www.cor.org/kindermusik](http://www.cor.org/kindermusik). Since there is some flexibility in the age ranges of the classes, you are welcome to attend a different Level class, as long as your child is still in the class age range. You are also welcome to attend a mixed-age class.

**SIBLINGS IN CLASS** – If you have an infant/younger sibling, they are always welcome to attend class with their older sibling and observe in a car seat/sling. Once the sibling has reached the age that they are an active participant in the class (probably around 6 months old) and spending the entire class on the mat with the other students, they will need to be enrolled in the class. We do offer sibling discounts if you email [Jennyn@cor.org](mailto:Jennyn@cor.org). You are also welcome to bring siblings to the Level 3 and Level 5 class sharing time.

If you have an older sibling that needs to occasionally attend class, they are welcome to sit at the table and play or watch class. We just ask that they not bring any toys that may be distracting to the class participants.

**WELLNESS POLICY** – We strive to provide a healthy learning environment for all of our class participants. We ask that you follow the general guidelines used by most preschools when deciding whether to bring your child to class. We ask that they be fever free for 24 hours, no rashes etc. We know that all children will have colds through out the winter. Please use your best judgement when determining you class attendance. We offer a very liberal make-up policy if you need it.

**CLASS CANCELLATIONS** – For weather related cancellations, we follow the Blue Valley School district. You will also be notified via email. In the rare case that a teacher is ill and we can not find a substitute, you will be notified via email. In both instances of cancellations, the classes will be made up at the end of the semester.
