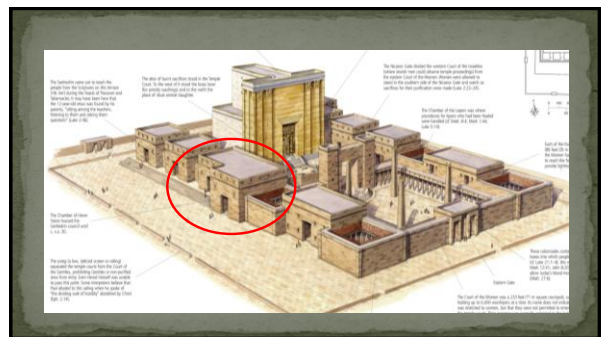
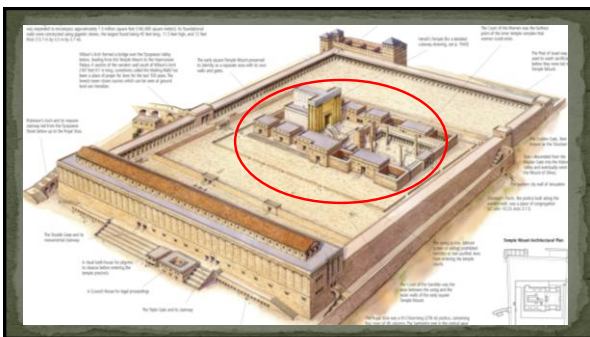
Last Supper	Sunset — 11 PM	Upper room	14:17-26

Initial Jewish hearing	12 – 1 AM	Annas' house	John 18:13-24
Second Jewish trial	2 – 3 AM	Upper room in Caiaphas' house	14:53-64
Physical abuse	3 AM	Caiaphas' house	14:65
Imprisoned	3 AM — 4:30 AM	Caiaphas' house	----

Mark's Timeframe of Friday

- **1** — "early in the morning the chief priests... held a consultation ... and delivered him up to Pilate."
 - Cf. "when morning had come" (Matt. 27:1); "when it was day" (Luke 22:66).

Mark's Timeframe of Friday

- **25** — "it was the third hour when they crucified him."
- **33** — "when the sixth hour came, darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour."
- **34, 37** — "at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice... Under a loud cry, and breathed his last."
- **42** — "when evening had already come, because it was the preparation day, that is, the day before the Sabbath, Joseph of Arimathea came... and asked for the body of Jesus."

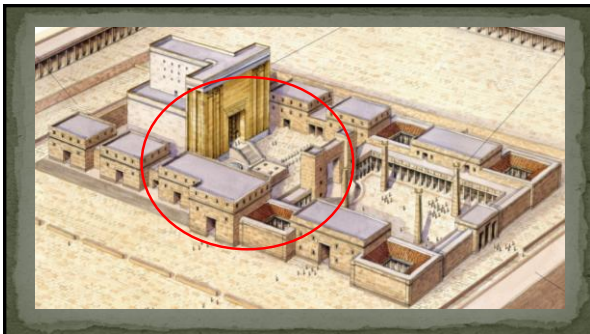
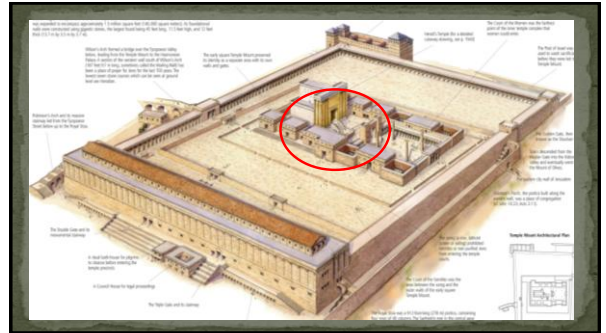

 - Cf. [Luke 23:1](#) - Then the whole body of them arose and brought Him before Pilate.
