- 1) According to our Deeds (6-10).
 - a) The Principle Stated (6)
 - Judgment is certain.
 - Judgment will be individual.
 - Judgment will be universal.
 - Judgment will be evidential.

Romans 2:6-10

Three Views of Rom. 2:7-10...

- 1) Offering salvation by works to all unbelievers.
[This view contradicts Scripture!]
- 2) Referring to God's reward of the obedience of those already saved by grace through faith.
- 3) Laying out the impossible condition for salvation by works apart from Christ.

b) The Principle Explained (7-10)

- 1) Group 1: Those who Seek Salvation by Human Effort (7, 10)
 - Their Direction (7a)
 - Their Ambition (7b)
 - Their Behavior (10)
 - Their Destiny (7, 10)
- 2) Group 2: Those Who Do Not Obey the Truth (8-9)
 - Their Ambition (8a)
 - Their Direction (8b)
 - Their Behavior (9b)
 - Their Destiny (8-9)
