IV. It Will Not Be A Human Being (35-37)

A. What Christians Often Experience (35-36)

1. Normal Trials — “Tribulation” (35)
2. Extended Trials — “Distress” (35)
3. Religious Persecution — “Persecution” (35)
4. Natural Disasters — “Famine” (35)
5. Financial Poverty — “Nakedness” (35)
6. Personal Danger — “Peril” (35)
7. Physical Violence & Death — “Sword” (35)

B. How Christians Always Endure (37)

How does Christ preserve and protect us?

1. By praying for us (Lk. 22:31-32)
2. By not allowing circumstances that would destroy us (John 18:4-9).
3. By strengthening our faith in God's Word (1 Pet. 1:3-9; 1 John 5:4).
4. By providing sufficient grace to endure (2 Cor. 12:7-10)
