4. God declares His verdict on the righteous & the wicked (22-23).

Psalm 50:7-15

I. The Sinful Thinking that Destroys Gratitude (7-13)

- A. God is pleased with my worship and obedience even if it's solely external (7-8).
- B. God demands from me what is really mine (9-10).
- C. God is really not good, generous, or loving (11).
- D. God needs me and my worship (12-13).

II. The Simple Changes that Restore Gratitude (14-15)

A. Change your Routine Patterns of Thinking (9-13)

1. God is only pleased when my worship and obedience are wholehearted (7-8).
2. God owns all things, has given me all I have, and only demands from me what is really His (9-10).
3. God is truly good, generous, and loving, richly supplying me with all things and graciously receiving me in Christ (11).
4. God is not dependent on me in any way, but I am totally dependent on Him for everything (12-13).
