# “All Israel will be saved.”

- **“Israel”**

- The physical descendants of Abraham

- **“All”**

- The vast majority of Israel but not necessarily every Jewish person without exception

- **“Will be saved”**

- Spiritual rescue from the guilt and penalty of sin
