### I. Think about Your Spiritual Gift Accurately (3-5)

A. What Does This Address? – Spiritual Gifts

B. Why Does This Matter? (3a) – A Command of Christ

C. Who Does This Concern? (3a) – Every Christian

D. What Does This Command? (3b)

1. Negatively – Don't think too highly of yourself and your gift.

2. Positively – Think accurately of yourself and your gift.

E. How Does This Happen? (3c-5)

1. Remember your unique ability to serve is a gracious, sovereign gift of God (3c).

2. Remember you are only one member of Christ's body and your role is to serve the other members (4-5).

# Biblical Periods with Miracle-working Men

## 1. Moses and Joshua

- From the Exodus (1445 BC) through the career of Joshua (c. 1380 BC)
- About 65 years

## 2. Elijah and Elisha

- From about 860 BC to 795 BC
- About 65 years

## 3. Christ and His apostles

- From the start of Jesus' ministry until (at the longest) John's death
- About 70 years

1. Apostle (1 Cor. 12:28; Eph. 4:11)
2. Prophecy (Rom. 12:6; 1 Cor. 12:10, 28; Eph. 4:11)
3. Distinguishing of spirits (1 Cor. 12:10)
4. Word of wisdom (1 Cor. 12:8)
5. Word of knowledge (1 Cor. 12:8)

## Temporary Sign Gifts

### Confirmation

6. Miracles (1 Cor. 12:10, 28)
7. Healings (1 Cor. 12:9, 28)
8. Faith (1 Cor. 12:9)
9. Tongues (1 Cor. 12:10, 28)
10. Interpretation of tongues (1 Cor. 12:10, 30)
