Diagnostic Test

Discuss results with your child's doctor and obtain referral to an Ear, Nose, & Throat (ENT) doctor.

Make appointment with a pediatric ENT doctor as soon as possible.

A pediatric ENT doctor is trained to specifically treat children who have been identified with hearing loss. This doctor also gives permission for a child to be fit with hearing aids, if desired.

Return to Audiologist for:

- additional testing (due to the need for more information about your child's hearing)
- hearing aid selection.
