

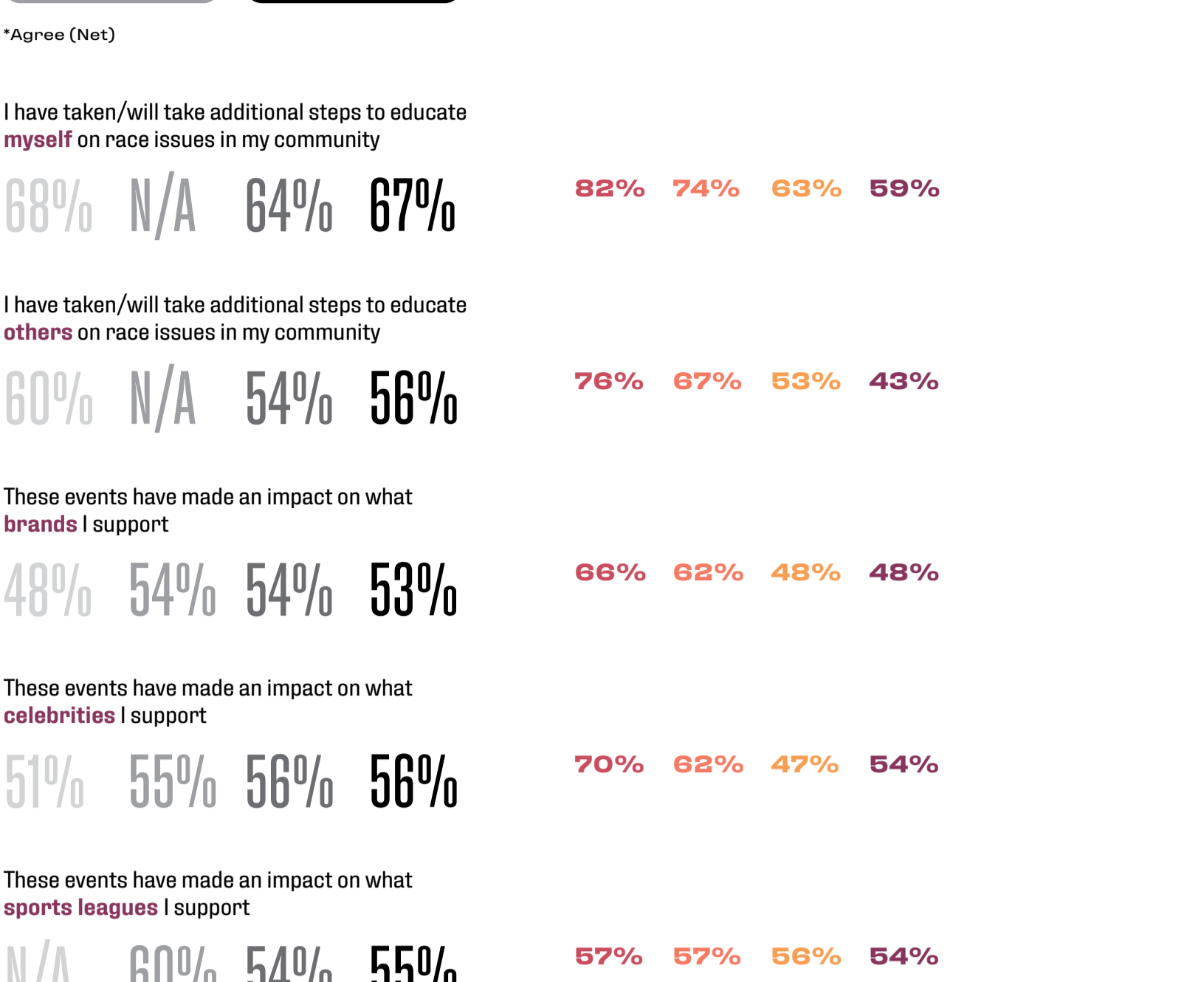
America's Response to Racial Injustice Over the Past Year

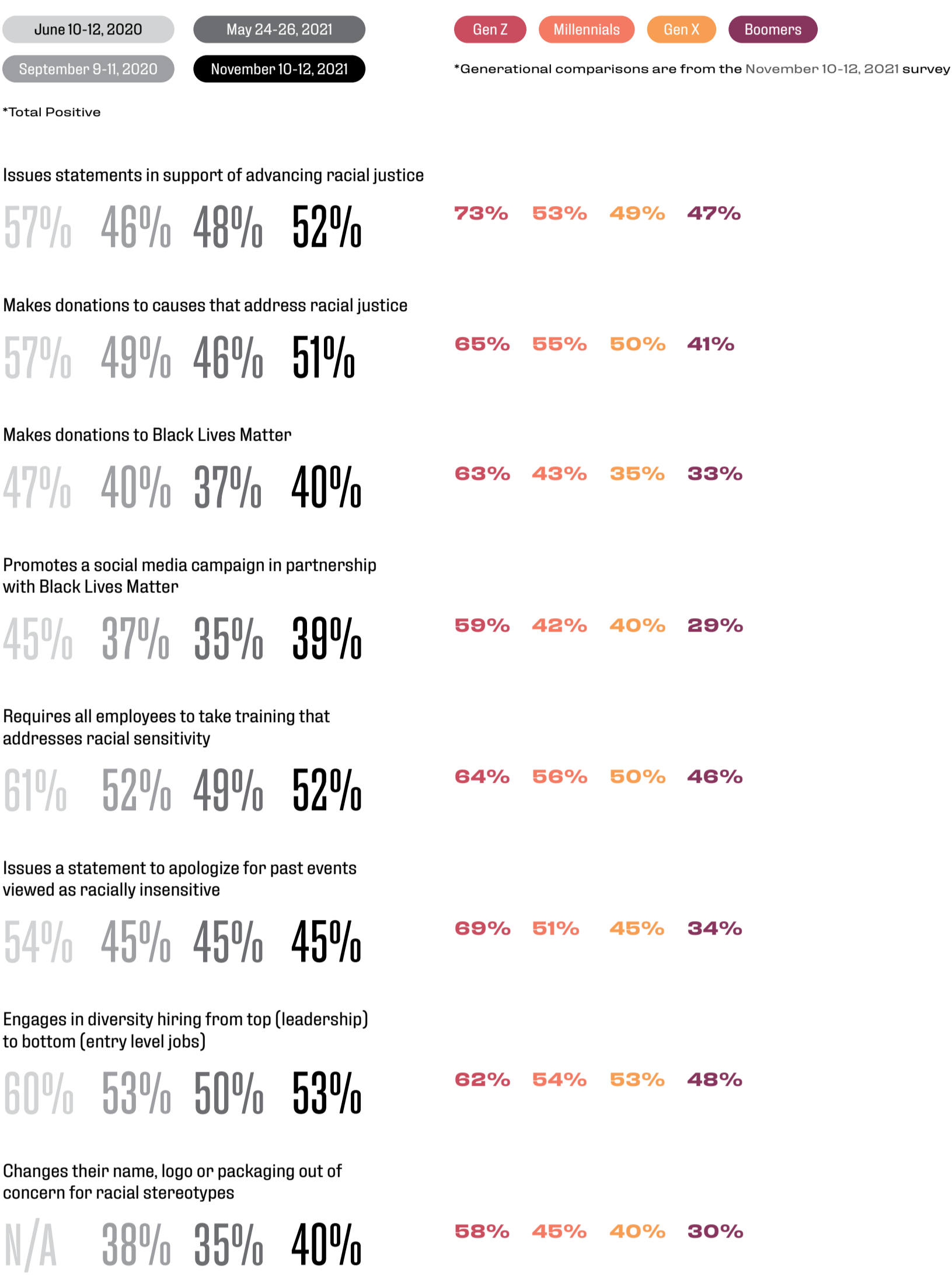

The findings released today unveil American's views on where we are compared to 18 months ago. This continues to be an important time in our country. ENGINE is proud to bring America's voice to the conversation.

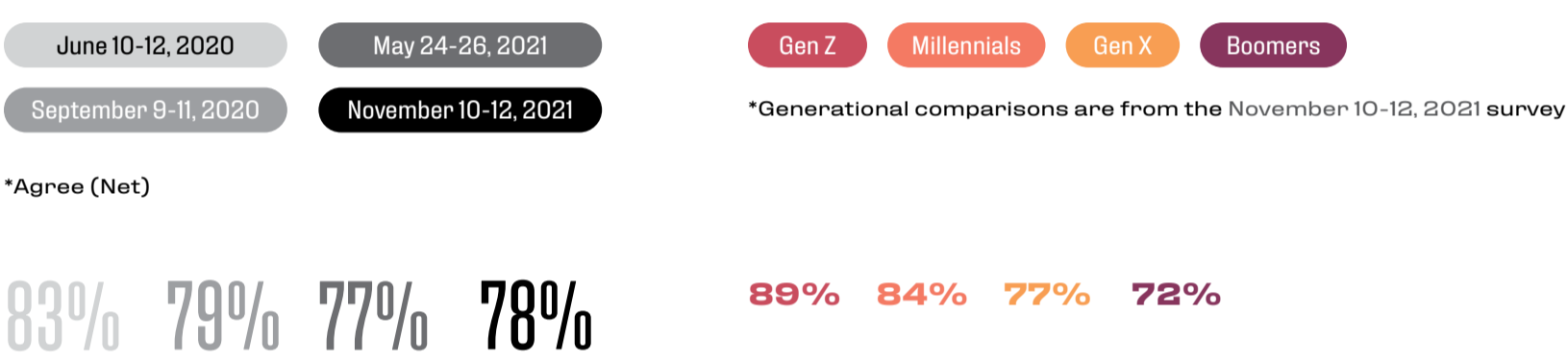

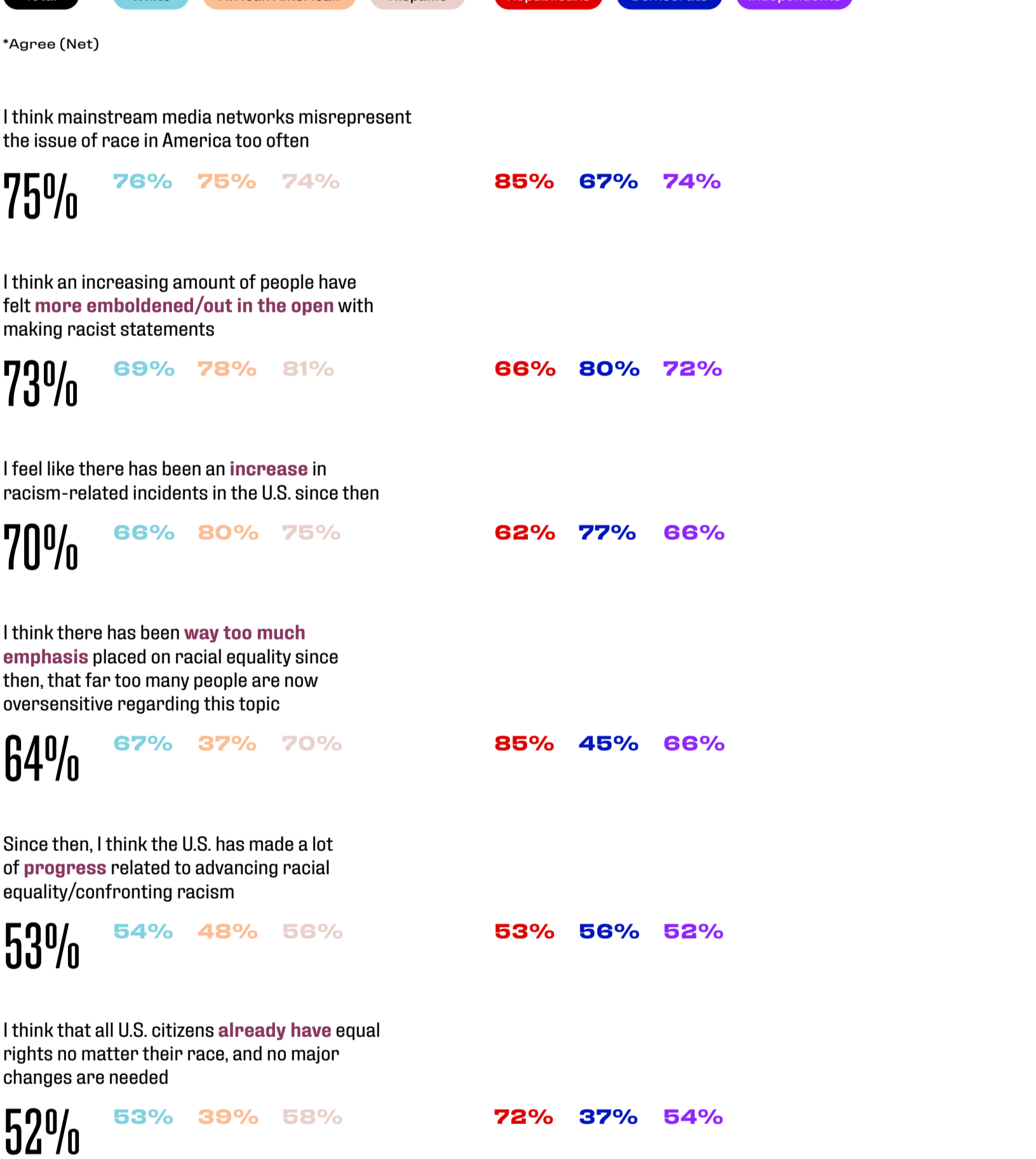
How would you feel about a brand/company that does the following?



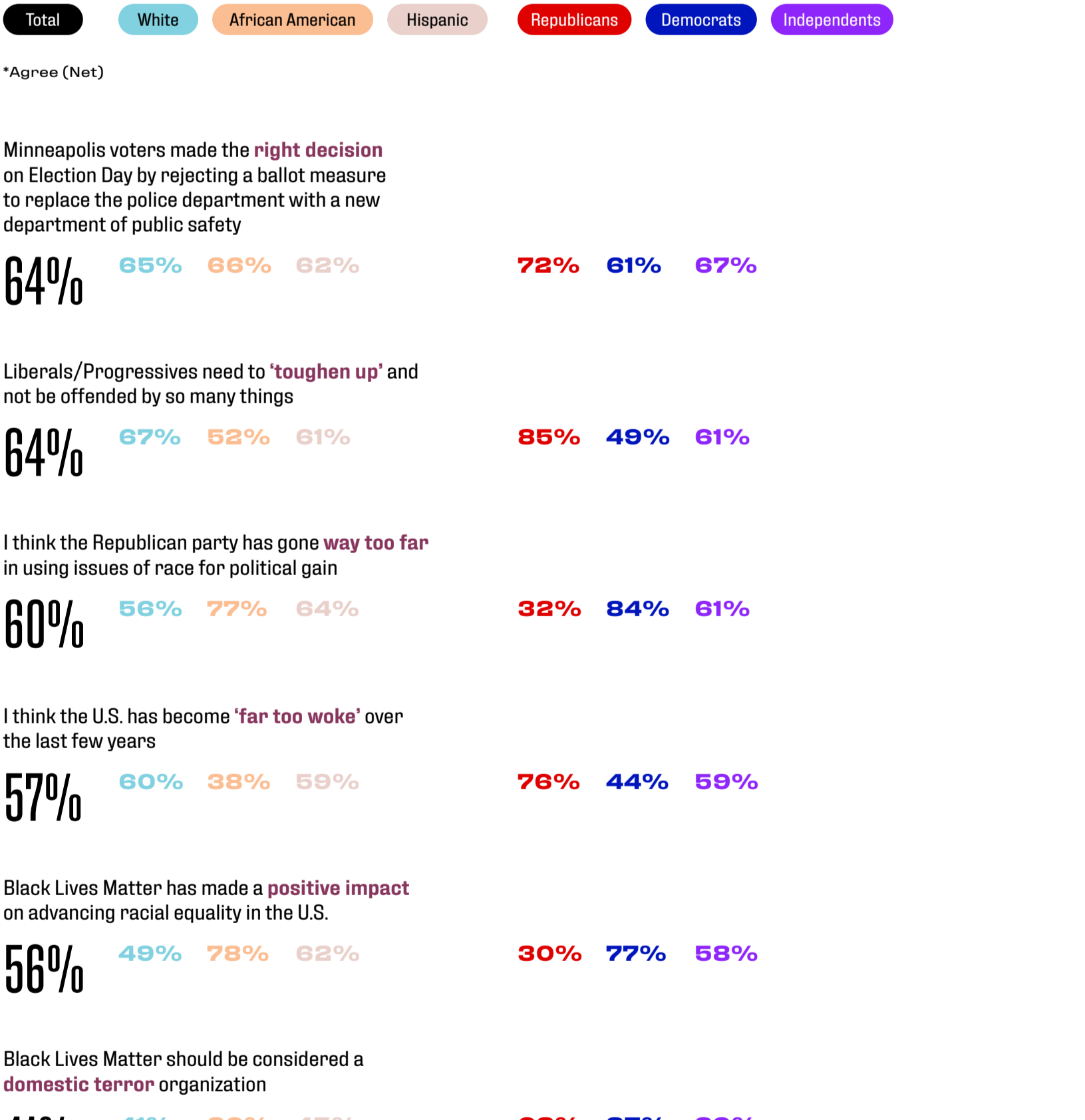
How much do you agree or disagree with this statement: **I believe there is still an issue of systemic racism in America.**



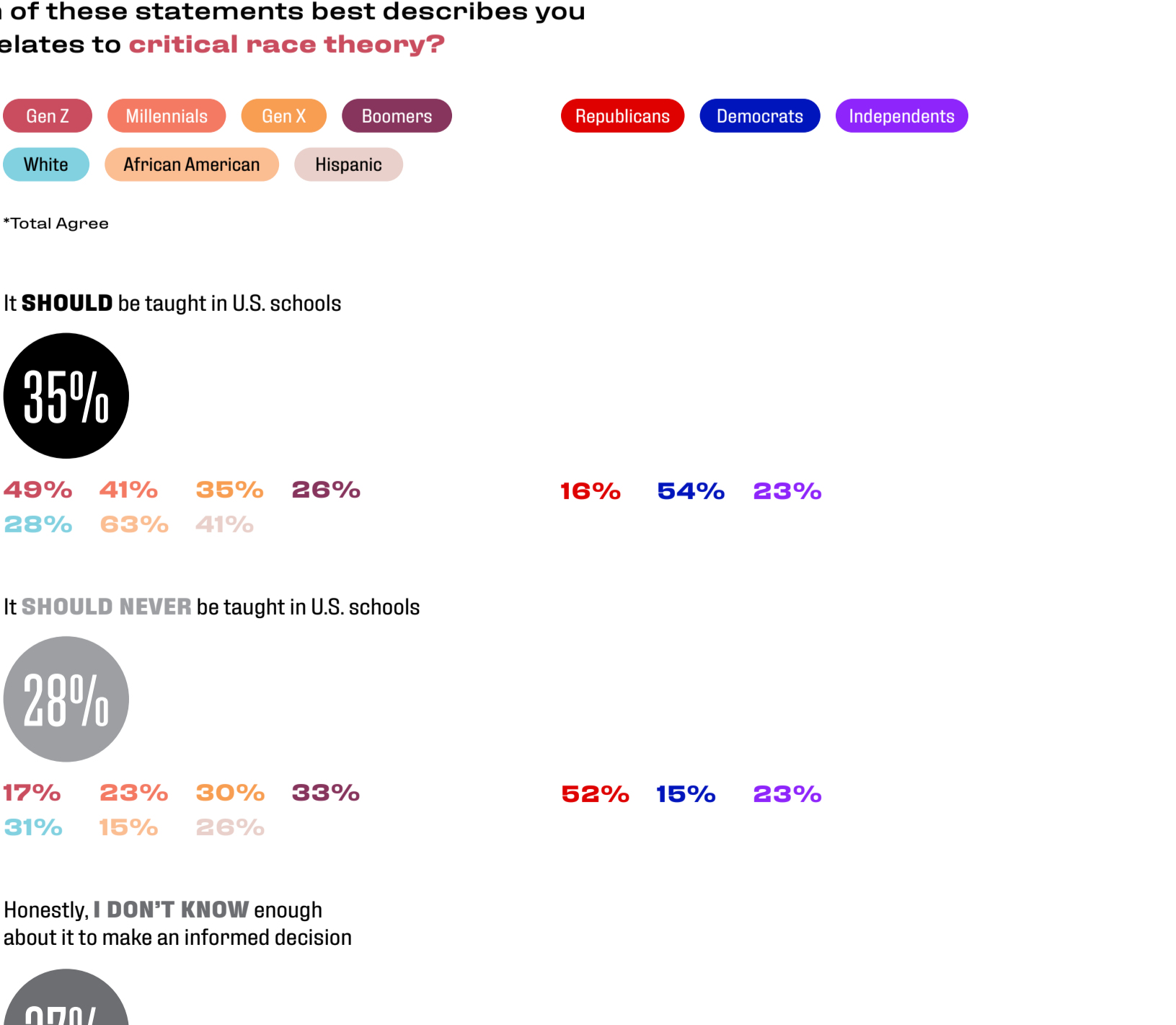
Thinking back to race relations in the U.S. over the last 18 months since the murder of George Floyd through today, to what extent do you agree or disagree with these statements?
