

People of Promise: Redeemed Through Discipline

2 Chronicles 36:15-16

"God's corrective providence (discipline) is meant to humble sinners, awaken deep heart felt contrition, and restore them through Christ mercy" Johnathan Edwards

"He has shown you, Oo mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God"- Micah 6:8

Big Idea: God's discipline redeems His wayward people by warning them with patience, welcoming them back with mercy, and walking with them through His shepherding presence.

❖ **God patiently warns His wayward people BEFORE He disciplines!** (2 Chronicles 36:15-16)

❖ **God provides a way for His wayward people to return AFTER He disciplines!** (Micah 7:18-20)

❖ **God pursues His wayward people with His presence DURING His discipline!** (Psalm 23)
