In April, the discipleship class (VANIA) began with at least 30 high school students in one of the high schools in Moyale town. Unfortunately, due to their demanding school schedule, we were unable to continue with our program in May.

By God's grace, another door opened in July to disciple 12 ex-candidates (teens who have completed their high school studies) in one of the churches in Moyale town. Our time together has raised their curiosity in the areas of discovering their identity in Christ and their purpose in life.

At the same time, I have had the opportunity to mentor two young Muslim convert girls – whose newfound faith has not only brought immense joy in their life but persecution. In addition to this, the girls come from poverty. This means they are unable to meet their basic needs while in boarding school.
