I am writing to express our deepest gratitude for the generous donations and support we have received from your congregation. We are incredibly grateful for your commitment to our ministry and the impact it has made on the lives of those we serve.

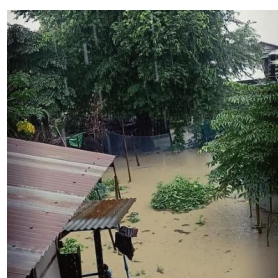
Your recent donation has enabled us to carry out our mission of providing assistance to war-displaced victims, building water pumps, and supporting orphanages and Bible college & seminary. Your support also enabled us to have our Head, Heart, Hand seminar at our college for the second year in a row. Your support has been instrumental in helping us bring hope, relief, and tangible resources to those in need.



Right now, there are 1.8million IDPs in Myanmar. The Junta troops have incinerated at least 53,816 homes all across the country. Inflation in Myanmar hit its highest level in a decade, making life more difficult for citizens struggling to make ends meet. Rice that used to cost 45,000 kyats a bag is now 150,000 kyats a bag. Because of your kindness, we have been able to distribute 140 rice bags and 80 bottles of cooking oil to families who are facing severe food shortages due to war displacement. This provision of sustenance has relieved the immediate burden on these families and ensured that they have access to nutritious meals.



Additionally, your contributions have directly contributed to the construction of 2 water pumps in areas lacking proper infrastructure. Just the past week due to continuous rain there were flooding in Kalaymyo just 50 miles from Tedim we were able to help with household essentials.





We are also grateful for your ongoing support in assisting orphanages and schools. With your help, we bought 3 sewing machines, a brand-new color printer, provide educational resources, and mentorship programs to college students and vulnerable children.



Once again, please accept our heartfelt gratitude for your generosity and support. Your involvement is a testament to the power of unity and reminds us that together, we can make a difference in the lives of others. Moving forward, we will continue to extend our support to those in need, adapting our strategies to address emerging challenges.

FAITH MINISTRY has been actively involved in serving remote communities in Chin State. These areas are characterized by rugged and mud roads that make access difficult, especially during inclement weather conditions. To address this issue and continue our ministry



effectively, we are seeking your support in acquiring an off-road 4x4 car specifically designed to navigate the treacherous terrain. This vehicle will not only facilitate our gospel trips but also enable us to provide timely humanitarian relief to those in need in these remote areas. Having a reliable and versatile off-road vehicle is essential for us to fulfill our mission effectively. It will enable us to reach villages and communities that have previously been inaccessible due to the impassable roads. With the off-road 4x4 car, we will not only transport medical supplies, food, and other relief materials more efficiently, but we will also be able to navigate the challenging terrain safely and securely.



We understand that fundraising for such a significant investment is not a small task. However, we believe that with the support and generosity of your congregation, we can make a tangible difference in the lives of the people we serve. The current market value for a suitable 4x4 used car in Myanmar ranges from \$40,000 to \$50,000 due to inflation and import costs. While this amount may seem daunting, we believe that, through the generosity and support of your congregation, we can reach our target and thereby greatly impact the lives of the people we serve. Any amount, big or small, will bring us closer to our goal and have a lasting impact on the communities we aim to reach.
