Dear Faithful Partners in the Ministry,

Greetings from Myanmar in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! I hope everybody is doing well that the Lord is blessing.

I am so eager to report to you the many great things the Lord has done in the past several months through our ministry here in Myanmar. During October 4-6, 2019, I conducted an evangelistic meeting in a town called Lamzang in Chin States. Scores of people received Christ as their personal Savior and hundreds rededicated their lives.



During October 8-10, 2019, we held the EBC Ministers conference in Tedim, Chin States. Some 200 pastors attended the conference. I taught three sessions during the day and preached once at the evening service. All the



pastors were refreshed and empowered by the Holy Spirit. They returned to their respective churches with a renewed spirit and zeal.



During October 24-27, 2019, I had the privileged to attend the second World Without Orphans conference in Chiangmai, Thailand. Since children ministry is a new territory for me, the conference was such an encouraging and enlightening experience for me.

Since the beginning of November, I began writing a book on Bible Difficulties. I still need to go a long way as I have so far finished only up to the book of Job. Please pray for me so that I can finish this book project in 2020.

During November 9-11, 2019, I preached at Naypyitaw, the capital of Myanmar to a few of high ranking government officials and hundreds of government employees. It was such a rare opportunity and the Lord blessed the preachings. I also visited our EBC missionary Dongpi and his family who works in Naypyidaw area.



On December 4, 2019, I underwent hernia operation which kept me in bed for almost a month. I missed a number of significant preaching opportunities due to my illness.

On January 31, 2020, the Lord helped us to conclude another academic year at the Seminary.

It was a blessed and fruitful year.

During February 19-21, 2020, I went to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia to preach to the Burmese migrant workers and refugees. Some 7000 attended the meetings. The Lord allowed me to witness such a tremendous working of the Holy Spirit.





During February 26-March 1, 2020 we held our EBC annual delegate meetings in a town called Cikha which is situated near Indian border. All the business meetings and worship services went very well. 7 representatives from the Hmong tribe who live in southern Shan state attended this delegate meeting. They are the fruits of our mission endeavor to the unreached people groups of Myanmar. I led the commissioning service for our 47 missionaries on the last night.

On March 2, 2020, I, along with two other EBC leaders went to a village called Selbung. We officially accepted 20 households who would like to join the EBC in that village.



My daughter is running a summer English and Bible school in Yangon while my son David is doing the same in Tedim, Chin State. It is a great

joy to serve the Lord hand in hand with my children.
