
We really need a laptop for her that she can travel with.

## Praises

### Oral Story-telling to reach muslim women

One of the special contacts we made at the conference is with a woman who teaches how to use oral story-telling (from the Bible) to reach muslim women. She has worked for 25 years in muslim countries, working with refugees and victims of war, bringing hope and healing to muslim women.

We are so excited that she has agreed to come to Georgia the first week of June to train us in this method. She will spend 3 days with us in training, then we will go together to one of the Azeri villages to practice this method, and then return to Tbilisi for debriefing and an additional day or two of training.

Our Azeri ladies who are starting post-abortion ministry with Azeri ladies in Georgia will attend, as well as Georgian colleagues and possibly a colleague from [K]stan. This is a true answer to prayer!

### Training for Azeri Ladies in [K]stan

Also, our two Azeri ladies in Georgia will travel to [K]stan after the Story-telling training, to attend post-abortion leader training, and then participate in a Forgiven & Set Free Bible study group as trainees. These two training opportunities will give them a firm foundation to begin ministry in Georgia among Azeri women.

Praise God for providing these wonderful opportunities.

I will be meeting with the Azeri ladies regularly before the training in June, as we pray together and brainstorm about how best for them to get started.

## Expanding our borders

The post-abortion healing ministry in Central Asia continues to grow. There is a strong team in [K]stan who now do Leadership Training themselves. I was with them in January, and observed as they taught all the basic topics. They did a fantastic job!

As a result of the conference in Turkey, we will have trainees from 4 other countries in Central Asia who will attend the next leader training in Kstan.

## Prayer Requests

1. My church will host a half-day seminar for woman in April or May, on the Sanctity of Human Life and post-abortion healing. My Georgian colleague and I will co-teach this seminar, and I'm hoping that a OB/Gyn doctor who is a member of my church will teach the section on human embryology. Please pray for this seminar -- For Tea and myself, for Nana (the doctor) and for the ladies who will attend.
2. Pray for the Oral Story-telling training in the first week of June. For Bobbie -- our trainer -- and for all of us who will participate in the training.
3. Pray for our story-telling practice -- ministering to Azeri women in Georgia. Please pray that God would prepare the hearts of the women ahead, and that we would not be fearful, but dependent on the Holy Spirit!
4. Pray for Elnare and Rubabe -- the Azeri ladies who are starting post-abortion ministry among Azeri ladies in Georgia. Please pray for them as they travel to [K]stan in mid-June for training, and also as they learn story-telling techniques. Pray that God would give them much wisdom, creativity and discernment in how to reach the Azeri ladies for Christ!
5. Pray for the Leader Training, and Forgiven & Set Free groups in Kstan in June. Pray for Dina, who is director of Post-abortion ministry in Central Asia.
