
Directions to download files from Abraham-Hicks Subscription Programs directly to your iPad or iPhone.

Since iPads and iPhones will not natively accept .zip and .m4b files, we have created this short tutorial to guide you through the process. **This tutorial is done in Safari on iOS.** 

**Step 1** - Go to the App Store and download "Documents by Readdle" located here.

The App page will look similar to this:



Note: This step **ONLY** has to be done the first time you begin downloading your files to your iPhone or iPad. You will return to this app in the future to access your downloaded files.

**Step 1:** Login if you have a username already, otherwise click the button to create a new MY ACCOUNT.


What is MY ACCOUNT for? You can use your account to register for workshops and digital audio purchases/subscriptions!

Step 3 - Enter your username and password and click "Log In"

**Step 4 -** Once you are logged in to your MyAccount, you will see the list of files that you have available for download here:




**Step 5 -** Tap (or select) the recording that you wish to download. For this tutorial, we will be using: *CHI\_IL\_9\_2\_17\_MST*.

**Step 6 -** Once you select the file that you want to download, you will be brought to the download page where you will see the file in three different formats (.exe, .zip, and .m4b).

For this tutorial, we will be using *CHI\_IL\_9\_2\_17\_MST*, although if you wish to use the .m4b to have your tracks in chapters, you may download that instead of the single track .zip file.

Note: Do not select the .exe when downloading your file. The .exe file is reserved only for Windows operating systems.




Step 7 - Tap (or select) the file to download. You will be prompted with this screen:




**Step 8 -** Click the "Download" button.

Note: Depending on your internet connection, this may take a little time to download, so pay close attention to the blue progress bar under the web address as it loads.




**Step 9** Once the file has been downloaded, you will be presented with a dialog on how you would like to save your file as seen in the following image:




Tap (or select) "Open in 'Documents'" and the file will be sent to the application that you downloaded in Step 1. You should receive a notification that the file was saved.

**Step 10 -** Tap (or select) the .zip file that you just saved and the app will automatically unzip the file. You will see a new folder with the audio tracks inside. - as seen in the photo on the right.



**Step 11 -** Open the blue folder created by the unzipping process and you will now have access to your files that you have downloaded.



Select the files that you wish to listen to and use the player as you normally would. Tracks will play in consecutive order after the playback begins.
