A	Sweetbay magnolia <i>Magnolia virginiana</i>	1	Creamy white; late spring	Tree	6-9/9-1	25 ft./20 ft.	Large, lemon-rose-scented flowers; large, glossy green foliage; prefers acid soil
B	Summersweet <i>Clethra alnifolia</i>	3	White; late summer	Shrub	3-9/9-1	8 ft./8 ft.	Fragrant flowers; grows best in acid soil; foliage turns yellow in autumn
C	Dwarf fothergilla <i>Fothergilla gardenii</i>	11	White; spring	Shrub	4-8/8-1	3 ft./3 ft.	Fragrant flower spikes; prefers acid soil; leaves turn shades of red, orange and yellow in fall
D	Red chokeberry <i>Aronia arbutifolia</i>	5	White to pink; late spring	Shrub	5-9/9-1	10 ft./5 ft.	Persistent, showy red berries; foliage turns shades of red, yellow and orange in fall
E	Black-eyed Susan <i>Rudbeckia hirta</i>	15	Gold; summer	Annual	4-8/7-1	1-3 ft./12-18 in.	Bright daisylike flowers with dark centers; sometimes behaves as a biennial
F	Calico aster <i>Aster lateriflorus</i>	8	Rose-pink; fall	Perennial	4-8/8-1	4 ft./12-24 in.	Cut back by half in midsummer to control the height
G	Canadian columbine <i>Aquilegia canadensis</i>	15	Scarlet and yellow; spring	Perennial	3-8/8-1	2-3 ft./12 in.	Nodding flowers and ferny foliage; reseeds easily to form colonies
H	Wild geranium <i>Geranium maculatum</i>	10	Pink; summer	Perennial	4-8/8-1	24-30 in./12-18 in.	Grows best in moist soil; glossy foliage
I	Turk's cap lily <i>Lilium superbum</i>	6	Orange; summer	Bulb	4-7/7-1	5-10 ft./18 in.	Flowers spotted with maroon; prefers moist, acid soil; vigorous; no fragrance
	Virginia bluebell <i>Mertensia virginica</i>	Scatter throughout the garden	Blue; spring	Perennial	3-7/7-1	18 in./10 in.	Spreading, reseeding perennial; foliage goes dormant after the flowers fade
