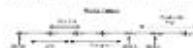

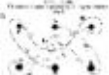

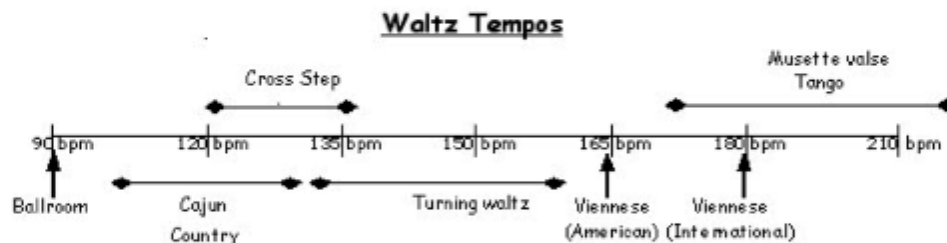

WALTZ (wôlts)

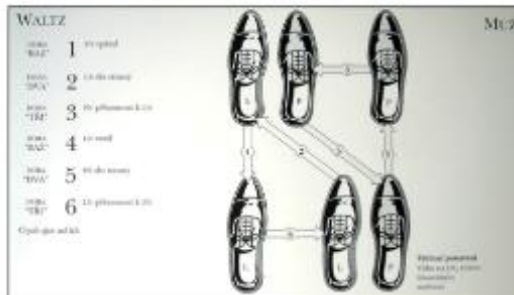
1. a dance in triple time performed by a couple who as a pair turn rhythmically around and around as they progress around the dance floor. (*noun*)

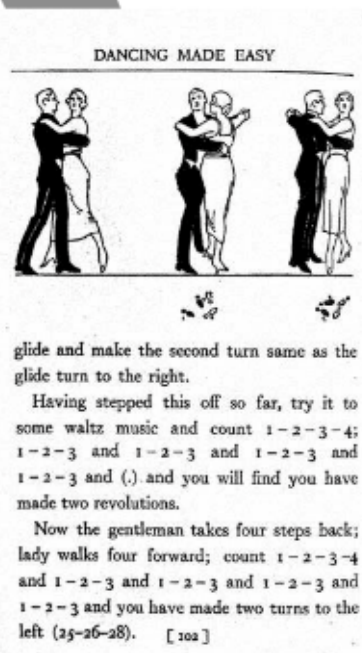

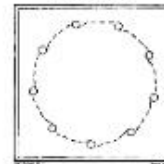

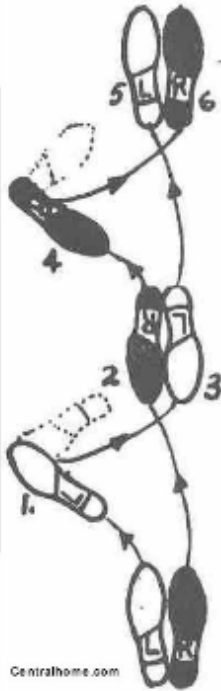

- Canceled due to low enrollment



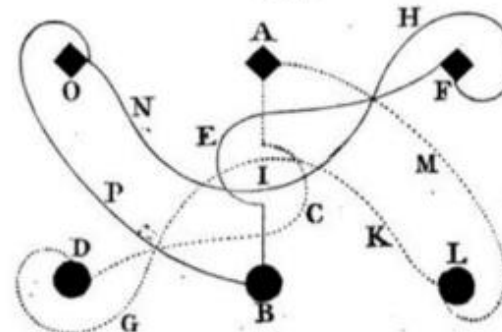

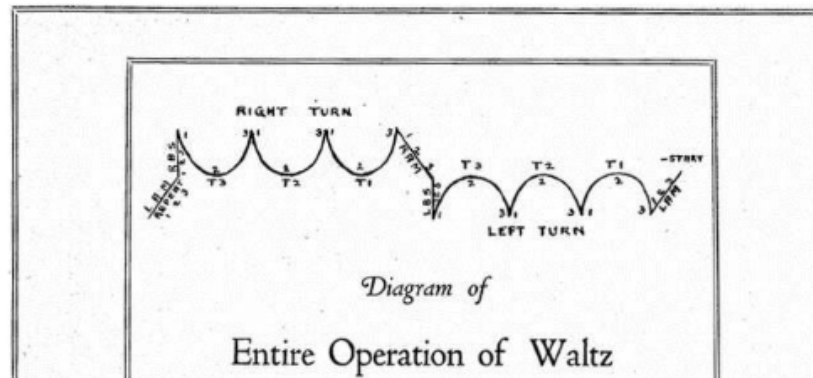
