## **Common Themes**

- ⇒ Engaging critical stakeholders, including executive leaders
- ⇒ Communicating early and often
  - Telling the completion story-using data
  - Making the case, communicating the goal, and sharing the story and early wins
- ⇒ Designing for the college context
  - Hiring and engaging the right people
  - Embedding our coaches and program designed to meet the needs of our campuses
  - Infusing the work into existing structures
  - Flexible, creative, nimble approach to project development
- ⇒ Committing significant time to partnerships and collaboration
  - Building strong, supportive partnerships with I.R. and I.T.
  - Regular Completion Coach meetings
  - Learning Communities

## **Challenges**

- ⇒ Competing initiatives; stakeholder burn-out; staff turn-over
- ⇒ Long-standing institutional policies and procedures
