Writing your story of personal faith in Jesus Christ is a wonderful way to reflect on how God has drawn you to Himself and changed your life.

As you write, make sure the focus is on God, what He has done, and is doing in your life.

I once was...

Spend a brief time on "before". This is not a biography from childhood. It is best to start at a time related to your experience with Christ.

But Christ...

Be as specific as possible about surrendering your life to Christ. What was happening at the time? How did Christ get your attention? If possible, share the month and year you were saved.

And now...

Be practical. Explain how Christ has changed your life. Share how you are growing in your walk with Christ. "Just as you have received him, so walk in him, rooted and built up and strengthened in the faith" (Colossians 2:6-7).

FOUR MEMBERSHIP COMMITMENTS

- 1) I have by faith become a follower of Jesus Christ, and I have been baptized as a visible way of demonstrating that commitment.
- 2) Because a disciple worships Christ, I will attend and fully participate in worship services at Redeemer.
- 3) Because a disciple walks with Christ, I will seek to maintain consistent disciplines of Bible study, prayer and personal witness. I will walk in fellowship with other believers at Redeemer by participation in a Small Group. To maintain unity in fellowship, I will neither criticize nor listen to criticism concerning any member(s) of this body and will, when personally offended, speak directly and lovingly with those involved.
