The Priority of Prayer and the Word

When the ministry of prayer and the word are prioritized, the gospel flourishes.

- Growing pain seasons can distract from the priority of prayer and the word. (v. 1)
- Ministry decisions should be made around the priority of prayer and the word. (vv. 2-6)
- The kingdom of Christ advances when the priority of prayer and the word remain central. (v. 7)
