

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 28:16-20. In verse 18 Jesus says that all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to him. What are some ways he backed up that claim in his ministry? (The resurrection, calming the sea, casting out demons, healing people.)

Read verse 19 again. Jesus commands his followers to go. What places has God called those of us in this room to go?

As we are going Jesus commands us to make disciples and baptize them. What does it look like to make disciples?

2. ASSESS YOUR HEART

Is there urgency in your attempts to make disciples?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

Why is it important to be in “the middle third?” What steps will you take this week to make sure you are in the middle third?
