HOW TO DESECRATE A TEMPLE

When I arrived back in Jerusalem, I learned about Eliashib’s evil deed in providing Tobiah with a room in the Temple of God. I became very upset and threw all of Tobiah’s belongings out on the street. Then I demanded that the rooms be purified... I immediately confronted the leaders and demanded, “Why has the Temple of God been neglected? Why are you profaning the Sabbath in this evil way?”...At the same time I realized that some of the men of Judah had married foreign women and their half their children could not speak the language of Judah at all. “Wasn’t this exactly what led King Solomon of Israel into sin?” I demanded. “There was no king from any nation who could compare to him, and God loved him and made him king over all Israel. But even he was led into sin by his foreign wives. (Nehemiah 13:7-9,11,17,25–26)

Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? What harmony is there between Christ and the devil? Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever? How can a believer be a partner with an unbeliever? And what union can there be between God’s temple and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: “I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.” Therefore, “Come out from among unbelievers and separate yourselves from them, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you.” And, “I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.” Therefore, since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that ruins our body and spirit, and let us work toward complete holiness out of reverence for God. (2 Corinthians 6:14–7:1)

3. Go _____



1. Get away from it.
